1. Habitats Regulations Assessment Report

1.1. Introduction

- 1.1.1. The European Commission's 2001 guidance on Planning for the Protection of European Sites: Appropriate Assessment identifies a four-stage process to the assessment of the effects of plans or projects on European sites. Cumulatively these stages are referred to as Habitats Regulations Assessment (HRA). The four stages are:
 - Stage 1 Screening;
 - Stage 2 Appropriate Assessment;
 - Stage 3 Consideration of Alternative Solutions; and
 - Stage 4 Assessment of 'Imperative Reasons of Overriding Public Interest' (IROPI).

1.2. This HRA Report

1.2.1. This is the HRA Report for Dogger Bank Teesside A & B. It reports on stages one and two of the HRA process, as identified above, and consists of the following documents:

 Appendix A - Habitats Regulations Assessment Screening Report (and appendices): sets out the steps taken to determine the designated sites and features that could be affected by the proposed wind farm development and the results of the Likely Significant Effect test.
